POLICE REPORT: Sgts John Lawrie, Dean Magennis and Superintendent Paul Fehon Words by Paul Fehon

- Positive results in the local community considering increase in population.
- Alcohol related crime over 10 year period; peaked in 2008 (when voluntary lockout was introduced) with 2085 incidents. Down to1498 incidents in 2016
- All incidents related to alcohol 18% in 2008 and 10% in 2016
- Alcohol related incidents in CBD (Horton, William and Shorts St); 80% reduction from 866 incidents in 2008.
- Assaults and street offenses also down. Move on orders are down.
- Move on incidences are down in licensed premises

General discussion

- Police want to see a safer community and safer working environment
- Summer proactive team. Bigger numbers of police in place for street offenses. Not focusing on licensed premises. FOTSUN, targeting drug use in particular.

Statistics for last 6 months:

- Incidents linked to licensed premises. Mid North Coast 324. Of this 264 in Hastings region. Of this, 229 in Port area. (June 43, July 22, Aug 55, Sept 49, Oct 42, Nov 18).
- Alcohol related crime; well below other areas. Mid North Coast 9% of above statistics. Hastings 11% and Port Mac 11%
- ID scanning can attribute to improvements in above statistics.
- Port Cup and Tastings On Hastings both went well. Less intox and street issues. Commend CBD premises in addressing intox.
- RSA cards electronic cards are now available. Good idea to keep registers still and view original cards, ensuring that venue is in touch with expiry dates.
- Pay attention to fire exits in venues, ensuring they are clear.
- 29th October covert operation. No issues to take back to venues. Hastings area rated medium low. Those in medium level more linked to street offenses.
- Ice forum at Panthers good attendance. Need to be conscious of this issue.
- Touch footy comp some intox, majority well behaved. Panthers closed midnight.
- Upcoming Laneway concert, Red Hot Summer Tour, FOTSUN, Christmas Parties. Restaurants and party boats to be audited.
- 23rd Dec proactive operation across Hastings. Checking RSA, IDs, pokie rooms)
